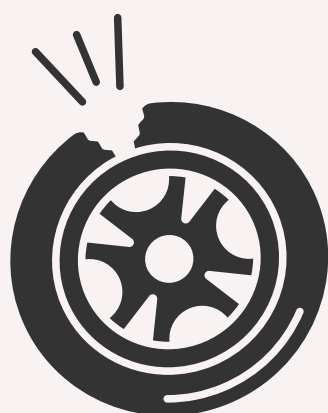
112 IN CASE OF ACCIDENT



In case of an accident in which you are badly injured and you need to be checked by a doctor, call the emergency number 112.

120 IN CASE OF BREAKDOWN



In Austria, if you have a membership card ÖAMTC and your bicycle breaks down on the road, you can call 120 and they will come to pick you up. More info [here!](#)

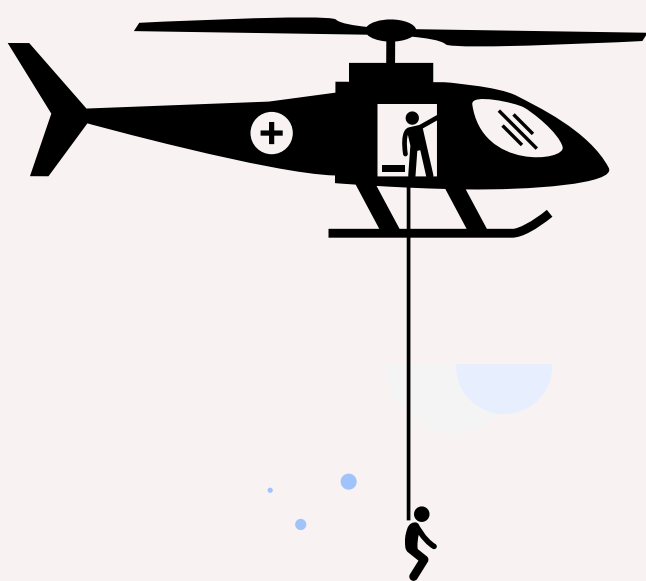
133 IN CASE OF THEFT



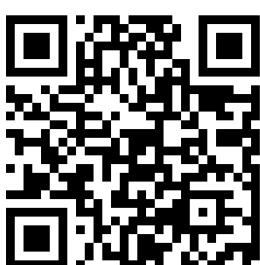
In case your bike was stolen, you have to contact the police, giving them all the information about the bike such as: frame number, description and a photo of the bike.

MOUNTAIN RESCUE



In case you are planning to go cycling in the mountains, in Austria or abroad, having AlpenVerein insurance or equivalent is recommended. It covers helicopter rescue in case of emergency, which otherwise would be extremely expensive. The same insurance covers you abroad as well and includes various adventure sports, that are not included with other insurance. [More info here!](#)
